

STUDENT CONDUCT GUIDELINES FOR STUDENT LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE

Alcohol and drugs

Students consuming drugs or alcohol, or found to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol at any time during the Conference will be returned home on the first violation.

Suggested Dress

Students are encouraged to wear casual, comfortable clothes for workshop activities and to dress appropriately for the more formal events (i.e. Ladies: Nothing so low as to reveal cleavage and skirts no shorter than 10 cm above knee. Gentlemen: No jeans. Shirts tucked in. Wear a tie if possible). Clothing that shows or advertises drugs or alcohol will not be allowed. Please do not wear hats inside the buildings.

Attendance

All students' delegates are to attend scheduled events, unless excused by their advisor. Students cannot deviate from the stated schedule to visit family and/or friends. Please be committed to stay until 11 a.m. Saturday.

Littering

Beverage and food containers must be placed in proper trash receptacles. If anything is spilled please notify an official immediately. We are guests of the facility and it is expected we will treat the locale with respect.

Smoking

This is a non smoking event.

Language and Behaviour
